1001 Inventions – Discover The Golden Age of Muslim Civilization

1001 Inventions is a global educational initiative that promotes awareness of a thousand years of scientific and cultural achievements from Muslim civilization from the 7th century onwards, and how those contributions helped build the foundations of our modern world. The 1001 Inventions global touring exhibition, sponsored by the ALJ Community Initiatives, and the educational products that accompany the exhibition all highlight the scientific and technological achievements made by men and women, of different faiths and cultures, that lived in Muslim civilisation. The 1001 Inventions exhibition completed its record-breaking residency at London's Science Museum with 400000 visitors in the first half of 2010, followed by a blockbuster residency at the iconic and historic Sultan Ahmed Square in Istanbul with a further 400000 visitors over a seven-week period. The exhibition then opened at the New York Hall of Science in December 2010, welcoming an additional 200000 during its five-month US premiere. The next venue on the 1001 Inventions exhibition's global tour is the California Science Center in Los Angeles where it will reside from May 27th 2011 until December 31st 2011.
